



1. Center Stage encourages students to be responsible and dedicated. Students must be punctual and attend class regularly. When a conflict arises, the student or parent of the student must notify the studio by phone or email.
2. Students can make up classes within two weeks of the missed class in a similar class. Students can only do so if the studio was notified by phone or email prior to the absence. The director must approve all make up classes.
3. Students who are chronically absent and do not make an effort to contact the studio and make up classes/learn show choreography may not be permitted to perform in our annual recital.
4. Dancers in the Center Stage Company have more specific guidelines for attendance; please see the company contract for further details.
5. Students are expected to arrive promptly to all classes and rehearsals. Arriving early and stretching is recommended for all students. If a student is 15 minutes late to class, it is the teacher's decision whether or not they can still participate.
6. In the event of an emergency or snow cancellation, an email will be sent to the email that is listed on your registration form. In addition, the cancellation will be posted on our website and Facebook page. When a class is canceled due to an emergency and/or weather, a refund will not be issued. Students may make up the class within two weeks in a similar class.
7. Center Stage reserves the right to cancel or combine classes due to enrollment, or as necessary.
8. If for whatever reason you plan on dropping a class, we require written notice at least two weeks prior to drop out month.



1. When you come into the studio please place belongings in the cubbies in the hallway or the cubbies underneath the benches. Coats can be hung up on the hooks by the window, but everything else should be placed in the cubbies.
2. No street shoes on the dance floors, only dance shoes.
3. During class be respectful of your classmates and the teacher. Be quiet and attentive while waiting to go across the floor.
4. No sitting during class, unless directed to.
5. No leaning on the barres, walls, or mirrors.
6. No gum chewing or eating during class.
7. Please keep cell phones on silent and refrain from checking them during class unless you are on a break.
8. Consistent attendance and effort is key to improvement. Students must be punctual and attend classes regularly.
9. Do not gossip, write or otherwise communicate negatively about others or yourself in or outside of studio. **BULLYING OF ANY KIND WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**
10. Clap at the end of each class for yourself, your classmates, and your teacher 🙌



Ballet/Pointe:

Girls: Black Leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes/pink pointe shoes, hair must be in a bun, no jewelry (stud earrings are okay), skirts are optional (no shorts)

Boys: Black cotton and/or Lycra pants, white T-Shirt, black ballet shoes

All other styles:

Girls: Form fitting clothes that allow for a wide range of movement, designated dance shoes (no socks), hair must be secured in a bun or ponytail, no jewelry (stud earring are okay)

Modern: No shoes required

Jazz: Black jazz shoes

Tap: Black tap shoes

Hip-hop: Black dance sneakers

Boys: Form fitting clothes that allow for a wide range of movement, designated dance shoes (no socks)

Modern: No shoes required

Jazz: Black jazz shoes

Tap: Black tap shoes

Hip-hop: Black dance sneakers

Company Rehearsals: All black dance attire with hair secured in ponytail or bun
